 - lament the wrong that you see
 - simply state it 'as it is' before God
- Friday v29-30 The Lord's Power
 - Still with the lament of yesterday in mind, ask God to enable you to speak His words with boldness and clarity
 - Remember that it is His power ...
 which can heal, perform signs and wonders all in the name of Jesus


