# Individual Mission Possibilities

Each and everyone of us interacts with other people, whether it is at work, the school gate, the gym, or through volunteering. It maybe that you are not able to contribute to the areas in this menu, but you are intentional about your witness in other areas. These are important too since they also form your personal “missional edge”.

Typical examples of your own “missional edge” are:

- Your workplace, e.g. among colleagues
- People you regularly meet, e.g. at the school gate
- People you meet for recreation or other interest, e.g. the gym, in sports, a book club and so on
- People you volunteer alongside in other activities

For a few of you it will be a struggle to be directly involved in the above activities. You will know that your calling and role is to support others who are involved in these various missional activities. You contribute to the mission possibilities of the church by giving people your faithful intentional support.
