

# Pass the ball ...

- Phone or speak to someone in the church you have not spoken to very often
- Find out something about them
- Say something to encourage them

Remember the Prayer Diary is a great source of who is in the church, and their contact details!

# Cheer on ...

- Make a point of thanking someone for the way they serve us as church
- Remember it could be something they do on a Sunday ... but equally it could be some way they minister or help others in the week

# Pray for the saints ...

- Remember to keep using the prayer slips to pray a blessing on someone else in the church – for example use one slip per week

*Lord Jesus, bless \_\_\_\_\_ today and draw them  
ever closer to You.*

# Overflow ...

- Talk to or contact a neighbour or friend
  - Get to know them better
  - Encourage them
  - Don't be shy about letting them know that you base your life on Jesus

# Play Internationally ...

- Have you considered the opportunities to serve Jesus overseas?
  - There are possibilities that are just a couple of weeks, or a few weeks, months ... and longer
  - Broaden your horizons, learn big time!
  - Help people who are often in desperate need

# Seek first to understand ...

- Do you know someone (e.g. at school) who thinks differently to you?

Then make a point of trying to understand them :

- First Pray
- Then ask them about their life at home, how they have grown up etc.
- Listen as you explore why they hold their views
